

DISTRICT NO. 7 COUNTY SUPERVISOR VACANCY

Public notice is hereby given that the elective office of Butler County Supervisor District No. 7 has become vacant effective November 18, 2024 due to the resignation of Supervisor Anthony Whitmore. Pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes §32-567 – §32-574, the vacancy will be filled within 45 days from the date of the vacancy by appointment by the Butler County Attorney, Butler County Clerk, and Butler County Treasurer, for the remainder of the term which ends January 6, 2027.

Pursuant to Nebraska law, the individual appointed to fill the vacancy must be a resident and registered voter in the district. Supervisor District No. 7 is comprised of the following area:

*Supervisor District No. 7 includes the following townships, namely: **Read, Ulysses, Plum Creek, and Richardson, and Sections 25 through 36 in Center Township, and Sections 13 through 16 and Sections 21 through 36 in Oak Creek.***

The current term of office for Supervisor District No. 7 ends on January 6, 2027. The current annual salary for this elected office as set by the Board is \$32,147.66 with a 5% increase effective January 1, 2025 and January 1, 2026. Health and dental insurance or cash in lieu thereof in the amount of \$500 per month and county retirement benefits are also included.

Applications can be mailed, hand-delivered, or emailed, but must be received by noon on December 9, 2024. The Butler County Attorney, Butler County Clerk, and Butler County Treasurer will convene public interviews of all applicants submitting timely completed applications on Friday, December 20, 2024 commencing at 10 a.m. in the Butler County Supervisor's room in the Butler County Courthouse.
