She explained that she had no issue with Steager Lawn Service providing the service, she has issue with the standby fee that is being charged. She explained the board needs to be conscientious on spending taxpayer dollars. Steager explained the process of how they clean the sidewalks and parking lots. Sypal mentioned she called around to other snow removal companies and they don't charge the fee. Steager proposed that they continue using his company's services for the remainder of winter, then in June/July they go out for bid; he also said he would remove the standby fee.
