May 19, 2025

A meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Nebraska was held on the 19th day of May 2025 at the Butler County Courthouse in David City, Nebraska at 9:00 a.m.

Present were the following: Tony Krafka, Scot Bauer, Scott Griess, Bob Coufal, Brad Vandenberg, Scott Steager. Absent: Jan Sypal.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by Publication, a designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Proof of Publication attached to the minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to the minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to all members of the board of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the meeting room.

County Clerk Lori Aschoff noted an error in the May 5, 2025, meeting minutes: Discussion/Possible regarding the 2018 Ford Explorer continued. Moved by Griess, seconded by Vandenberg, to sell the 2018 Ford Explorer upon receipt of the new one. Upon roll call vote the following voted:

Set date and time to open gravel and culvert bids for the 2025-2026 fiscal year

Highway Superintendent Randy Isham will need a couple weeks to run the publications soliciting bids for gravel and culverts. Chairman Steager noted the RFB needs to include a requirement for monthly or quarterly billing. Moved by Coufal, seconded by Krafka, to set date and time to open gravel and culvert bids for June 16, 2025, at 9:05 a.m. Upon roll call vote the following voted:

Discussion/Possible Action – Department of Roads One- and Six-Year Plans

Isham noted that a bridge northeast of David City needs to be added to the One-Year Plan, but he believes the materials needed are already on hand at the yard. He has a meeting scheduled with the Seward County Roads Department about a bridge at the Butler/Seward County line on 21 Road. Replacement of the bridge will be cost-shared with Seward and needs to be added to the Six-Year Plan. Discussion tabled until the next meeting so the bridges can be added to the One-and Six-Year Plans.

Roads Update

Crews worked on Q Road last week; hopefully the material will stick better with the recent rainfall. White rock may need to added. The sand road is finished and just needs to be graveled. Crews will be moving to 31 and RS Roads; some of the ditches are full and the road needs to be leveled out. They also worked on River Road last week; it looks good and is very

smooth now. Memorial Day weekend is coming up so crews will make sure all of those roads are ready to go. Isham is waiting to hear on the shredder that was ordered.

Visitor Jamie Eickmeier expressed concern about the new gravel pit, which is located in a flood plain. If/when the river floods again and the water can no longer go through the pasture currently there, his property is going to be flooded. Eickmeier presented a map of the flood plain to the Board. Isham noted that the County has hired JEO Consulting to provide gravel pit engineering and that they will include the 100-year flood in their study. The new gravel pit contract will not be signed by the County until JEO completes the study and impact on neighboring properties is reviewed.

Consideration/Approval of Amended and Restated Agreement for the Formation of the Region V Community Human Services Program and Region V Systems continued

Chairman Steager and County Clerk Aschoff received a renewal quote for Medica from Rick Schneider/Jones Insurance with a 9% increase in premium for next fiscal year. HR Coordinator Heidi Loges noted that she had not received any complaints from employees regarding Medica. Aschoff stated that she had received a couple of positive comments from employees about Medica. Steager requested that insurance be added as a discussion item for the next meeting and that Rick Schneider be invited to attend for questions, etc.
