#### February 18, 2025

A meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Nebraska was held on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February 2025, at the Butler County Courthouse in David City, Nebraska at 9:00 a.m.

Present were the following: Scott Steager, Tony Krafka, Scot Bauer, Scott Griess, Robert Coufal, and Brad Vandenberg. Absent: Jan Sypal.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof, by Publication, a designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Proof of Publication attached to the minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to the minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to all members of the board of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the meeting room.

Chairman Steager called for a moment of silence for NSP Trooper Kyle McAcy, who was killed in the line of duty yesterday in a traffic crash on Interstate 80.

Chairman Steager declared the minutes from the previous meeting shall stand approved as presented.

#### **County Clerk Monthly Fee Report**

The County Clerk fee report for the month January 2025 was accepted and placed on file. Chairman Steager asked how much of the doc stamp tax is retained by the County. Aschoff could not recall. Steager noted that there was discussion at a recent NACO conference about a potential increase in the percentage retained by counties.

#### **Monthly Sheriff Report**

The Monthly Sheriff Report for January 2025 presented before the board. It was accepted and placed on file.

Clerk Aschoff explained that VSP (vision insurance) premiums need to be paid for the current month, while payroll is paid a month behind, which can make it difficult to calculate the amount due. Discussion held regarding Sheriff Dion's request to update the Step Program. Chairman Steager called for a vote on the tabled motion from the last meeting, which had been moved by Coufal and seconded by Bauer. Upon roll call the following voted:

Discussion was held regarding the importance of training, particularly in-person training, as well as competitive wages. After discussion with the Sheriff on these issues, it was moved by Coufal, seconded by Bauer to approve a 3% increase to the BCSO's Step Program, providing that a minimum of 16 hours of deputy training required by the State be completed via in-person training. # Discussion/Possible Action – Review/acceptance of bids for replacement of the 911/Courthouse battery backup system

Chairman Steager noted that the two existing battery backups were obsolete in 2018. When the power blinked off and on a few times several days ago, it took out the board on one of the units which is not reparable. Both units need to be replaced. Three bids were received for the replacement of the battery backup system. 911 Coordinator Bowers is researching whether the 2914 fund can be used to pay for the project.

3. Holloway Electric LLC \$53,953.98

Chairman Steager noted that Woolsey's bid includes a battery bypass that the other bids do not. This would enable Dispatch to continue to operate during equipment maintenance. Considering that and citing Woolsey's familiarity with the building's electrical system, it was moved by Coufal and seconded by Vandenberg to approve the bid from Woolsey Electric LLC for \$62,442.90, to be paid for using the 2914 fund if possible or, if not possible, the inheritance fund. Upon roll call the following voted:
