A meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Nebraska was held on the 18th day of August 2025 at the Butler County Courthouse in David City, Nebraska at 9:00 a.m.

Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to the minutes. Availability of the agenda was communicated in the advance notice and in the notice to all members of the board of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the meeting room.

Discussion was held regarding wage increases and whether evaluations should be conducted by the Board as a whole or by the appointed employee's committee/liaison. Discussion tabled until later in the meeting.

Roads Update

Isham reported that they are getting a number of smaller jobs done, culverts, ditches, hauling gravel, etc. Some roads are a little soft after the recent rain, but not bad. Once things dry out Isham plans to work on 35 Road going east. The road at Linwood is getting very narrow in spots so they may need help again. Skull Creek should be running their machine by October. Hopefully things dry out soon, but rain is forecasted off and on for the next week.

Discussion/Possible Action regarding wage increase and evaluation process for appointed employees, continued Discussion continued. Moved by Vandenberg to have the Board Chairman or Vice Chairman serve on the committee for an appointed official with no committee. Motion withdrawn. Moved by Vandenberg, seconded by Krafka to approve a 2.70% cost-of-living increase along with the following scale for merit-based increases based on each employee's evaluation score:

Eval. Score: 3-3.5 = no additional Eval. Score: 3.5-4 = additional 2.00% Eval. Score: 4-4.5 = additional 2.50% Eval. Score: 4.5-5 = additional 3.00%

Open sealed proposals for the development of a Comprehensive Plan and zoning regulations

A letter was received from Miller & Associates stating that they are unable to submit a proposal at this time. A proposal was received from Hanna:Keelan Associates with a total cost not to exceed \$57,000.00. Chairman Steager appointed Bauer and Griess to serve on the Zoning Committee; they will reach out to some of the other counties Hanna:Keelan has worked with and check references. Planning Commission applications are due August 29th. Applications are available in the County Clerk's office.

Discussion/possible action regarding purchase of a new patrol vehicle

Sheriff Tom Dion requested approval to purchase a new patrol vehicle to replace the vehicle that was totaled. He presented the Board with an informal bid from Reinicke Motor Co in Schuyler for \$47,976.00. He has funds available in the equipment sinking fund to cover the difference from the insurance settlement. The department has a total of seven vehicles, four of which are currently being used. Dion noted he has three deputies starting at the academy in September. Deputy Cory Burtman is also recovering and plans to return to work as soon as he can. That leaves three vehicles for four deputies, so they need to replace the totaled vehicle. Moved by Krafka, seconded by Vandenberg to purchase the 2025 Police Interceptor from Reinicke Motor Co in Schuyler for \$47,976.00. Upon roll call vote the following voted:

Nay: NONE. Motion carried. Chairman Steager requested that Dion let him know when he hears from Applied Connective about the equipment from the totaled vehicle so an insurance claim can be submitted to NIRMA.

2025-2026 County Budget Update

The budget is currently sitting slightly higher than last year; the budget committee conducted interviews with a few department heads last week. If no other changes are made to the budget, the levy would be 0.155%, which is lower than last year. We are waiting to hear from NIRMA about the insurance claim for the totaled patrol car.
