BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

September 24, 2025

A meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Nebraska was held on the 24th day of September 2025 at the Butler County Courthouse in David City, Nebraska at 9:00 a.m.

Present were the following: Scott Steager, Tony Krafka, Scott Griess, Bob Coufal, Brad Vandenberg. Absent: Scot Bauer, Jan Sypal.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof, by Publication, a designated method for giving notice, as shown by the Proof of Publication attached to the minutes. Notice of this meeting was given to all members of the Board and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to the minutes. The availability of the agenda was communicated in advance notice and in the notice to all members of the board of this meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the meeting room.

The Chairman declared the minutes from the previous meeting shall stand approved as presented.

Special Public Hearing for Final Tax Request

Moved by Coufal, seconded by Vandenberg to open the special public hearing for the 2025-2026 Final Tax Request at 9:02 a.m. Upon roll call vote the following voted:

Chairman Steager noted a public hearing was held last week regarding the budget and invited any other Board discussion. Supervisor Krafka suggested cutting the Planning Costs line item to \$75,000.00 since the proposal from Hanna: Keelan came in lower than expected. Supervisor Griess suggested an additional \$100,000.00 be transferred from Inheritance to the General Fund for tax relief purposes. Discussion was also held regarding falling interest rates on the County's investments; County Treasurer Karey Adamy noted that she has investments locked in through the fiscal year, but interest rates are coming down and are a full percentage point lower than they were a month ago.

Chairman Steager invited public comment; there was none.

Moved by Vandenberg, seconded by Coufal to close the public hearing at 9:15 a.m. Upon roll call vote the following voted:

Moved by Coufal, seconded by Krafka to reduce the Planning Costs line item to \$75,000.00 and transfer an additional \$100,000.00 from Inheritance to the General Fund in order to provide property tax relief. Discussion held. Upon roll call vote the following voted:

County Clerk Lori Aschoff presented the board with the following revised property tax request information:

- The 2025-2026 property tax request be set at:
 - a. General Fund: \$4,864,155.44b. Ag Society: \$ 193,102.16

Total \$5,057,257.60 decrease of -0.6% from previous year

- The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 17.778%.
- The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$0.150614 per \$100 of assessed value.
- Butler County proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$0.149784 per \$100 of assessed value.
- Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of Butler County will increase last year's budget by 9.124%.

WHEREAS, a proposed County Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026, prepared by the Budget Making Authority, was transmitted to the County Board on the 24th day of September 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of SUPERVISORS of Butler County, Nebraska as follows:

SECTION 1. That the budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026, as categorically evidenced by the Budget Document be, and the same hereby is, adopted as the Budget for Butler County for said fiscal year.

SECTION 2. That the offices, departments, activities and institutions herein named are hereby authorized to expend the amounts herein appropriated to them during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026.

SECTION 3. That the income necessary to finance the appropriations made and expenditures authorized shall be provided out of the unencumbered cash balance in each fund, revenues other than taxation to be collected during the fiscal year in each fund, and tax levy requirements for each fund.

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-34

WHEREAS, Butler County, Nebraska ("Butler County") provides a public safety answering point ("PSAP") which receives 911 service calls and either dispatches emergency services or relays calls to the appropriate public service agency, and

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Public Service Commission, pursuant to the Enhanced Wireless 911 Services Act, has set a surcharge to be collected by wireless carriers and paid by their wireless customers to help fund certain costs of E-911 Wireless, and

WHEREAS, Butler County receives a portion of the surcharge funds from the Nebraska Public Service Commission, and is allowed to save or set aside up to 75% of the funds received for future equipment/software purchases and upgrades, and

WHEREAS, for the fiscal year 2024-2025 all funds received were deposited into the 911 Wireless Service Fund (2913),

WHEREAS, Butler County is allowed to set aside funds in the amount of \$23,105.99; the amount remaining from fiscal year 2024-2025 for future equipment/software purchases and upgrades.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Butler County Board of Supervisors that the Butler County Treasurer be hereby directed to transfer \$23,105.99 from the 911 Wireless Service Fund (2913) to the 911 Wireless Service Holding Fund (2914).
